Garfield County School District (GCSD) provides assurances that it will follow procedures in accordance with Federal and State law and USBE Rules, including compliance with the USBE and Federal Programs.

State and federal legislation often rely on free and reduced-price school meal eligibility as an indicator of student socioeconomic status, which helps determine critical supports that schools receive, such as Title I funding under the Every Student Succeeds Act.

Lunch applications are found on your child's ASPIRE account.

- **Log in to each child in ASPIRE.**
- **Scroll down on the right side of the screen to find the Free/Reduced Meal Application box.**
- **Click on the box.**
- **Then follow the directions.**
- **You may apply in English or Spanish.**

Paper applications are available in your school office. However, you are encouraged to complete an online application instead of a paper application if you are able. The online application has the same requirements and will ask you for the same information as the paper application. Visit to begin or to learn more about the online application process.
